



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# Maintenance instructions Railcar Trailer hitch 80800

### General note

Regular maintenance of the hitch should normally be undertaken every six months, where in the frequency of maintenance is dependent on the frequency of use.

#### Lubrication note:

- 1. Make sure that all moving parts (e.g. the lock, the mounting base, the handel, the chain wheel, etc.) are always sufficiently lubricated or oiled.
- 2. The mounting base must be cleaned.

## Information regarding suitable lubricants and the areas to be lubricated can be found in the lubrication schedule for Railcar Trailer Hitch 80800.

#### CAUTION: DO NOT APPLY BUFFER GREASE !!!

#### Inspection note:

- 1. Inspect the hitch plate and the height-adjustable base unit. Replace missing or damaged screws or nuts where necessary.
- 2. Inspect the hitch plate lock for signs of damage or excessive corrosion. If necessary, replace the lock.
- 3. Inspect the release handles for signs of damage. Make sure that the Release handles are not bent of out shape and function properly.
- 4. Inspect the release handle spring. Missing or damaged springs must be replaced.
- 5. Inspect the height adjustment locking bolts. Bent or damaged bolts must be replaced.
